# Water Baptism

This year we are going to be performing a "water baptism" service in Terra Alta Lake as part of camp. Rev. Paul Snyder the Pastor of the Corinth Pentecostal Holiness Church will be coming to camp to perform the service. Due to varying beliefs about water baptism we are requiring a parent's permission for their child to be baptized, and wanted to share information with you concerning baptism.

The Corinth Pentecostal Holiness Church holds fast Jesus' command in Matthew 28:19 of the bible "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit". We see in Matthew 3:13-17 that Jesus himself was baptized by John.

We do believe in full submersion Baptism.

Water baptism is considered a continuation of the work that was started when you first asked Jesus into your heart. It's a way to show openly that you've asked Jesus into your life. Water baptism is not just for new converts, it is also for those who want to re-commit their lives to God, or just re-confirm their commitment.

The water baptismal service at Camp will be a great opportunity for your child to show his/her commitment to Christ with their friends as witnesses. If you are not opposed to your child taking part in the baptismal service, please sign a permission slip, **even if your child doesn't want to be baptized at this point in time their opinion may change during camp week. We will not allow any child to be baptized without written permission from a parent!**

We also want to encourage parents to attend this service. The Service will begin at 7 PM on Monday August 15 and be held at the cross at the Terra Alta Lake. It will start with a devotion and end with the Baptism. We will allow time for the youth to call and remind or invite Parents to come.

# What to bring!

## “A Good Attitude!”

Soap, Washcloths and towels (for showering and the Canoes)

Fans are allowed and encouraged in the cabins.

Clothes for five days (Pack for indoor and outdoor activities)

Shorts,(No short shorts please approve your child’s clothing, Nothing tight.) We will have “CAMP” shorts on hand for replacement of inappropriate clothes. T-shirts Extra shirts you may change thru the day if you sweat a lot. No thin tank tops (tank tops must be at least two fingers thick) or belly shirts or anything that shows your bra strap.

Sun block

Swim Trunks or Bathing suit either a one piece or a cover-up

Swim Goggles for the lake (in case of mud battle)

Sweatshirt or Jacket

Socks, underwear (You may want extra socks in case your feet get wet in any outdoor activities)

Tennis Shoes I would recommend a spare pair in the event one gets wet.

Flashlight (extra Batteries)

Umbrella or rain gear

Snacks for late night in the cabins. No energy drinks! Soda and candy are fine. Only in sealed original containers.

Camera (I recommend disposables in case they get lost but it is your choice)

Please label items if your child has trouble keeping track of their things.
